I am pleased to inform you that 54th MP State Aquatic Championship-2026 (Sub-Junior Boys & Girls / Mini Boys & Girls) to be held at 16th July to 18th July 2026 at INDORE M.P. (Swimming) will be organized at Laxmen Singh Chouhan Taran Pushkar Mahunaka Indore MP, by Indore District Swimming Association under the auspices MADHYA PRADESH SWIMMING ASSOCIATION.

The Championship will be held in the following Sub Junior age group in Swimming for Boys & Girls, in accordance with latest Asia Aquatics Rules.

SWIMMING- SUB JUNIOR BOYS & GIRLS

- Group- II 13-14 years - Born in the year 2013, 2012
- Group- III 11-12 years - Born in the year 2015 & 2014

- Free Style 50, 100, 200, 400 m
- Back Stroke 50, 100, 200 m
- Breast Stroke 50, 100, 200 m
- Butterfly Stroke 50, 100, 200 m
- Individual Medley 200 m

The Championship will be held in the following MINI age group in Swimming for Boys & Girls. (Promotional Event)

IMPORTANT

- All Swimming events will be conducted as per latest World Aquatics Rules, Event will be held in 50 m pool.
- All swimming events will be conducted as heats & finals (except 400 m FS, 200 m IM, 200 m Fly)
- Only top 8 times swimmers in the heats will progress to the final.
- All finals will be held in evening session.
- **SWIMMING EVENT WILL BE CONDUCTED WITH ONE START.**

ENTRY RULES –

- No more than 2 entries will be permitted for each event in both genders from each district. In the final event,
- Swimmers (Athletes registered on SFI General Management System(GMS) database and having a Unique Identification Number(UID) duly renewed for FY 2026-27 i.e., valid UID, before last date of sending the entry will only be eligible for participation.
- Having a valid UID is an eligibility criteria and swimmers must qualify as per procedure mentioned in circular from his/her District under which they have registered on GMS system.
- Print/ Digital copy of valid UID card will be carried by swimmers and presented when reporting at competition venue and requested to do so by the official in- charge of conduct of event.
- As per the SFI guide lines in Sub Junior (Boys & Girls) shall be allowed to enter in maximum 5 Individual events in the championship.
- As per the MPSA guide lines in Mini (Boys & Girls) shall be allowed to enter in maximum 3 Individual events in the championship.
- **LAST DATE FOR SUBMISSION OF ONLINE ENTRY IN ALL RESPECT IS 12 JULY 2026.**
- No Reserve player will be permitted to participate in the Individual Events.

Relay Entries

- Name for relay team/s will be submitted by respective team manager on hour before the session start in the prescribed form/ Google form, non submission of relay team forms will result in team exclusion from relay events. No exception will be permitted relay names should be only from the registered players for the event.
- Medals and certificated will be awarded only to the finalist of the relay.

Entries Fees & Entry Procedure

- Registration fees Rs.500/- , Entry fees Rs.50/- per event per head, Relay team fees Rs.200/- per team (Relay) will be paid to MP Swimming Association by member unit entry fees if remaining unpaid before start of the 1st event team will not be permitted to participate.
- Entries will be received in ONLINE SYSTEM by the members units only last date for submission of entry on (online system) 12 July 2026 members unit will be required to send to MPSA the full result of their District championship/ selection trial by email within 3 days after submission of online entries, failing to do so online entries will not be entertained, units are encouraged to contact state championship instead of selection trials as far as feasible for team.

Withdrawals

- Individual event withdrawal for any swimmers may be submitted by the team manager/ coach during or immediately after the team managers meeting, All withdrawal will be submitted in prescribed form and shall be counter signed by swimmer, no penalty will be charged but entry fee will not be refunded.
- Swimmers who qualify for the finals and not wishing to take part in a final in which qualification was earned shall withdraw within thirty minutes following the preliminaries (heats) of the event in which the qualification took place.
- Any withdrawal thereafter will be treated as failure to report for finals and will invite a penalty of Rs. 1000/- or disqualification from the remaining events of that day.

Awards & Certificates

- The top 3 times from finals for each event will be awarded medals (Gold, Silver & Bronze) and merit certificates.
- The Top 3 times for 400m FS, 200m IM, 200m Fly events (timed event) will be awarded medals (Gold, Silver & Bronze) and merit certificate.
- Medals and Certificates will be awarded to the Finalist of the Relay event. Certificate reprint request due to damage or loss will be charged at Rs. 500/-.
- As per M.P.S.A. General Councils decision the Birth date of each participant will be entered on the participation as well as winner certificates.
- Trophy for “Best Swimmer” (Sub Junior Boys & Girls /Mini Boys & Girls) awarded to swimmer with highest number of individual Gold in respective gender, in the event of a tie, swimmer with maximum new meet records will be given higher weightage, In absence of a new meet record, the number of silver medals will be taken in consideration, Best swimmer award will be given to Indian citizen only.

Ceremonies

- The opening ceremony will be conducted on day 1 before start of evening session; all members units will ensure participation of minimum 05 athletes in good ceremonial dress/ state sport kit.
- All units will ensure the team shall carry (at least one) official flag for the opening ceremony and ceremonial march in.

Travel & Accommodation

- Teams will make their own travel arrangements.
- Shared accommodation will be provided by organizing committee at subsidized rate.
- Team/ Player requiring support for subsidized accommodation will be required to submit accommodation request in given form not later than 10 days before start of event, this facility will be available for player/ team official only.
- If requirement of subsidized accommodation is not received in prescribed form with arrival details and rooming list by stipulated deadline, no accommodation will be allotted to the player/ team.
- Shared transfers from & to departure point (Rly Station/ Bus Stand) will be made available by organizing committee subject to arrival/ departure details submitted in given form not later than 7 days before start of event.

Meals

- Breakfast/ Lunch/ Dinner will be provided at venue for those who wish on purchase of meal coupons subsidized meal coupon can be purchased at venue for the entire duration of the event to team manager only, Day wise coupons will not be sold, Number of coupon provided will not exceed the number of swimmers entered by the district, coupon will be provided for competition days plus one day prior. Meal coupon Rs. 500/- .

General

- NO EXTRA TEAM OFFICIAL PERMITTED WITH THE TEAM

MEDICAL BOARD/ Anti- Doping Protocols

- The President MPSA/ will appoint a scrutiny committee (Medical Board) consisting of three member & two local Doctors to determine the age of the participants as decided by MPSA. Necessary action will be taken against those who furnish incorrect information and/or certificate in regard to age etc. Swimmer will not be permitted to participate in the State as well as National Championship on recommendation of the Medical Board.
- MPSA firmly endorses the principles of clean sport.

MEDAL CEREMONY

- Players will ensure that they come for 'Victory Ceremony' in their District kit if no District Kit is provided swimmers will present themselves on podium in full length bottoms and covered torso only.

MANAGER MEETING

- A meeting of all the Team Managers and the Technical Officials attending the Championship will be held on 15th July 2026 at 6.00 pm at the event venue kindly inform your arrivals number of player & Officials.

SECURITY DEPOSIT

- Under the accommodation provided by the organizers, it will be mandatory for all district units to deposit a security fund of Rs 5000/- for the goods. This amount will be refundable, if no loss related to you has come to notice.
